


Sinpo International Market Food: Sinpo Korean-style Sweet and Sour Chicken


- Al Travel Recommendation After completing a simple survey, the application recommends personalized travel courses to suit the user's travel preferences and the best routes for movement.

Open Port Area

With the opening of Jemulpo Port in 1883, modern open port streets were created in Incheon. Nowadays, it is popular among tourists for its museums, exhibition halls, hotels, and unique cafes, allowing them to feel and understand the old-time Korean culture.

Incheon Art Platform

Once a warehouse dating back to the opening of the port, the building has been transformed into a complex for art and culture. The historic building and various works by resident artists attract visitors' attention.

Incheon Open Port Modern Architecture Exhibition Center



The delicate building miniatures allow you to see the inside and outside of the buildings at the same time. It is a space for modern history and culture that retains the history of 100 years since the opening of Incheon in 1883. You can find features of Incheon from this historic era, still existing in modern buildings, along with those destroyed and lost to time.

Qing and Japanese Concession Area Boundary Stairs

Don't miss out on the Qing · Japanese Concession Area Boundary Stairs if you visit the Open Port. Chinese culture and Japanese culture are facing each other from across the street (left: China, right: Japan). It is noteworthy that you can see Chinese architecture with columns and red accents and Japanese-style buildings made of wood at a glance. There is Chinatown on the left side, and climbing up the Qing· Japanese Concession Area Boundary Stairs leads you to the Statue of Confucius and Jayu Park.

What Is a Concession?

This is a zone where foreign residents are permitted to stay and are granted extraterritorial rights in the Open Port area.

Hongyemun



Built in 1908 by the Japanese Army's engineering battalion for delivering supplies, Hongyemun is a stone gate resembling a rainbow connecting Incheon Port and Jeon-dong, Jung-gu. The gate retains its original form, making it a valuable asset for historical data about Japanese engineering methods and materials.

Dapdong Cathedral of St. Paul



Built in the 1890s, Dapdong Cathedral of St. Paul is a brick-based Gothic structure and is one of the oldest examples of Western-style modern architecture among all Korean Catholic churches. Its sharp dome across the central upper part of the main tower and the upper part of the small towers on either side make for a complex and beautiful facade.

Noodle Platform



Noodle Platform is a culture complex using noodles as the central theme – a first in Korea. A variety of content related to noodles is presented in exhibits and videos, along with tasting sessions for an assortment of noodle-foods from different countries and regions.

Jemulpo Club (Gurakbu)



After the opening of the port, people from the United States, Germany, and Russia gathered at this club to share their social life. The 'Gurakbu' is a Japanese expression for club. There are various events held here every month as a storytelling museum that displays images and videos about the opening of the port and modern history. Jayu Park



Also known as Manguk Park, Jayu Park was the first Westernstyle park in Korea. When the statue of General MacArthur, who became famous in Korea for the Incheon Landing Operation, was erected here, the name was changed to Jayu Park. You can view Incheon Port and Incheon Sea, and can also enjoy beautiful cherry blossoms here in the spring.

Wherever You Go, All Chinese Foods Served in Chinatown Are Delicious!

If you don't taste any Chinese foods while visiting Chinatown, you are really missing out on one of the greatest joys in life. Although each Chinese restaurant creates different tastes with their Jajangmyeon, Jjamppong, and Tangsuyuk, you will find them even better than you had expected, wherever you go.





If You Go to Incheon, Will You Find any White Jajangmyeon?

It is a mistake to think that all Jajangmyeon is black. White Jajangmyeon is made with traditional Tianmianjiang (sweet bean sauce) without MSG and color additives. As such food reserves as ground meat and onions are mixed together with white seasoned beans, it looks white and tastes light.

Make Your Trip More Joyful with Street Foods

When you walk on the streets in Chinatown, you will surely find some Chinese street foods here and there. Popular Chinese street foods, such as Gong-gal Bbang (bread) without stuffing, sweet red bean bread, Hongdubyeong, and Tanghulu, traditional Chinese snacks made with fruits and sugar, will make any visit to Chinatown feel more pleasant.





Chinatown

With the opening of Incheon Port, the Qing Dynasty Concession Area was established in Chinatown. The streets are filled with colorful buildings in Chinese style, harmonizing red and gold colors. It is also a pleasure to taste the Korean-style Chinese cuisine and various street foods.

Pai-lou

Opposite to Incheon Station, a huge Chinese traditional gate welcomes visitors. When you encounter the delicate sculptures and brilliant colors, you will find yourself taking photos of the landmark. An iconic symbol of Chinatown, there are four pai-lous (Junghwamun, Inhwamun, Seollinmun, and Hanjungmun Gate) in Chinatown.



Statue of Guan Yu

At the entrance of Hanjungmun Gate, you can see the Statue of Guan Yu riding a horse. There is a belief that Guan Yu is the God of Wealth, so you can get rich by touching his hands three times.

Three Kingdoms Mural Street-Chohanji Mural Street



Three Kingdoms Mural Street is located on the left hand side of Qing and Japanese Concession Area Boundary Stairs. It is a 150-meter-long street featuring 77 stories from the Three Kingdoms, including Oath of the Peach Garden, Calling Thrice at the Thatched Cottage, and Battle of Red Cliffs, Chohanii Mural Street

is located not far from Three Kingdoms Mural Street. It features 56 stories about such heroes as Xiang Yu, Liu Bang, and Han Xin.

Korean-Chinese Cultural Center (Incheon Overseas Chinese History Hall)



Here you can experience the distinct cultures of both Korea and China. The 1st floor has permanent exhibition halls to display art and culture, and the 2nd floor has miniatures of Chinese landmark buildings. The Incheon Overseas Chinese Historical Hall, which is an annex, shows the genuine life of Chinese settlers who came to call Incheon home.

Jajangmyeon Museum



Jajangmyeon was first made in Incheon. This motivated the foundation of a theme museum providing all information about Jajangmyeon. As this building was established by remodeling the old Gonghwachun Restaurant (Modern Architecture Cultural Heritage), the birthplace of Jajangmyeon, tourists can look around the fancy restaurant from some 100 years ago with exhibits.

Trip to Incheon Islands by Ferry

Incheon Port Coastal Ferry Terminal is located on Yeonan Pier. Visitors can board passenger ships bound for islands in the West Sea, such as Palmido Island, where the Korea's first lighthouse was installed, and Baengnyeongdo Island, situated at the northernmost tip of Korea. Make sure to carry an ID card to board a ship.

World's Largest Mural on Silos

The Silo (grain-storing warehouse) Mural, located in the Inner Port of Incheon, consists of a total of 16 silos as large as a 22-story building. The 16 murals on the silos show how a young boy grows into a farmer. It was registered as the world's largest outdoor mural in the Guiness World Records. At night, the stories of the mural are transformed into an eight-piece media facade (an art form that uses the exteriors of buildings as screens for projecting images).


Wolmi Park

Wolmi Park is formed around Wolmisan Mountain as a perfect place to enjoy time with family or loved ones. The park features 11 hiking tails, one of which was recently formed as the 'Road for the Disabled in the Forest,' carved out for anyone with physical disabilities to experience accessible movement and enjoy in comfort and safety. The park's Wolmi Korean Traditional Garden offers a beautiful garden recreated in the traditional style of the Joseon Dynasty, while the Wolmi Cultural Center offers a variety of programs to experience traditional culture, as well, such as Hanbok (Korean traditional costume), Hansik (Korean food), and traditional games.

Songdo **International City**

Songdo International City is not just a tourist destination. As the center of the Incheon Free Economic Zone, it is a world-class city with 15 international organizations. As such, the cityscape is modern and beautiful. The eyecatching architecture creates a sophisticated urban atmosphere, while the nation's top-class green spaces and parks give the city some fresh color.

Tri-bowl

The culture complex known as, Tri-bowl, broke the stereotypes for buildings. This structure takes the form of three bowls (containers). If you enter the building, you will feel that you are in a very different sort of architectural building altogether. Based on the theme of spiral spatial beauty, it was built by combining natural beauty with a modern architectural structure. You can enjoy culture and arts in the amphitheater-shaped theater and multi-purpose cultural space. In the evening, the exterior of the building is tinted with lights, serving as a good background for taking pictures of the night view

Songdo Central Park

Songdo Central Park is a seawater park. The 1.8km long waterway, which is designed to bring in sea-water, shines in the sunlight. As a Songdo's representative tourist attraction, it enables visitors to enjoy a water taxi ride, water sports, and cycling. At night, the light pouring in from the buildings and the lights illuminating the park create a fantastic night view.

The four sides are made of class, so you can have a view of Songdo International City and Incheon Bridge at once. The G-Tower is home to several international organizations, including

The oddly formed rocks, strangely shaped stones, and wave-patterned rocks, which seem to be fossils of a huge clam as tall as an adult, look profound and mysterious. You will be fascinated by the beautiful glow of the setting sun here. Ongam Beach is a famous camping site. Big and small pretty pebbles fill this beach. The sound you make when walking on the pebbles is unique. At the end of these beach, there are strangely stark rocks,

and if you see observe them during the sunset, you will surely appreciate them even more. On the opposite side, there is Seonmido Island, a lighthouse island.

There is a special charm to Deokjeokdo Island trekking. This is because travelers here can enjoy hiking facing various islands and the coast line of Deokjeok Archipelago.

It takes about 6 hours to hike and you can stroll through the woods enjoying many needleleaf trees along the way.



Soyado Island

Located close to Deokjeokdo Island, this island is now accessible by crossing Soyadaegyo Bridge, making it essentially a connected land. Soyado Island still preserves its natural appearance as it is. Ttebburi Beach is one of the major attractions. In summer, many people visit to enjoy the wetlands as well as sea-bathing. In particular, it is frequented by those wanting to gather clams. The sea, islands, and ships that you might encounter while crossing Yeondogyo Bridge look dazzling in the blue.

Gulupdo Island

Gulupdo Island is a popular destination among backpackers. If you slowly climb to the center of the island along its ridge, you will see a beautiful coast line becoming entwined.

It would be a great pleasure to see the strange rocks and bizarre stones as well as a herd of deer in the hills, and the island also boasts of Mokgimi Beach and Keunmal Beach with fine sands.

Daeijakdo Seop (Mussel)

Seop looks like a mussel, however, its size and taste are completely different. Seop is collected mostly in April, and its signature dishes include Seoptang and Kalguksu.

Puldeung



This is the highlight of the trip and can only be seen only on Daeijakdo Island. It is a sand island, also called 'Pulchi', which shows its appearance only at low tide. The sand island appears for about six hours a day, and when the water comes out, it disappears in a flash. You can step on the beach only when you go at the right time. The whole shape of Puldeung can be seen from the summit of Buasan Mountain.

Jageunpuran Beach



You can see the beautiful sea by walking the deck lining the beach. When you walk on the deck, the oldest rock in Korea attracts your attention. There is also a pavilion at the end of the deck, offering you a break.



Seungbongdo Island

lille Beach

When the sun shines, the beach shines with its silvery sand. Unlike most tidal flats on the west coast, the tidal flats here are not exposed during low tide, so the water is clear. The lush pine forest surrounds the beach, so you can take a nice stroll here at sunset.

Chotdaebawi Rock (Candlestick Rock)

It is called Chotdaebawi Rock because it is shaped like a candlestick that stands up to the sky. This rock is located on the edge of Mt. Sorigaesan at the end of the southeastern wharf on Seungbongdo Island. You can also see the Samhyeongje (Three Brothers) Rocks where three rocks are gathered.

Namdaemunbawi Rock (Kokkiri Rock)



This rock formation is located on Mongdol Beach on Seungbongdo Island, and it only shows itself at low tide. It looks like a giant gate like Namdaemun. People also call it 'Kokkiri Rock' because it looks like a Kokkiri (an elephant) from a certain angle. The sea between the rocks shines with more of a green tint against the rocks.





Jawoldo Island

Mokseom Island is a place that you should not miss out on in a trip to Jawoldo Island. It is located along a coastal road on the right hand side of Dalbawi Pier. As a footbridge connects to Mokseom Island, visitors who pass this bridge will feel as if they are walking on the water. Jawoldo Island is also well-known for its pine trees, soft sand, and fishing from the rocks on the seashore.


From this northernmost island in the West Sea, you can see Jangsangot in North Korea on a clear day. It takes more than 4 hours to reach from the Incheon Coastal Ferry Terminal, but it is an island you should visit at least once. Recognized as Baengnyeong and Daecheong Geopark in 2019, it has drawn a lot of attention. It is especially famous for Baengnyeongdo-style cold noodles, fermented sand eel, and Baengyeongdo wormwood.

Kongdol Beach

Whenever you walk on Kongdol Beachwhich is preserved as Natural Monument (No. 391), you can feel the smooth stones under your feet. 2 km-long coast is covered with gravels. You can walk barefoot or lie down and rest here as if you were taking a hot bath. The crashing of the waves against the gravels on the beach is itself another element of healing.





Dumujin

You will be fascinated by the stunning coastal scenery, trange rocks, and bizarre stones. While you can have a whole view of Dumujin from the ferry, you can take a closer look at the inside of Dumujin while walking. From the top of Dumujin, you can view the land of North Korea.

Baengnyeongdo Must-try Foods



Sagot Naengmyeon (cold noodles)



Sagot Naengmyeon on Baengnyeongdo Island is a delicacy. This Hwanghaedo-style Naengmyeon (cold noodle) is made with high buckwheat content. Beef bone broth seasoned with Baengnyeongdo sand lance sauce makes the soup extra rich and sweet.

Yongteurimbawi Rock (Twisting Dragon Rock)



Two rocks rise in a twisted shape toward the sky. You can feel the mystery when seeing such a rock. Rising up against the sea and sky, it stands opposite to the Nampo-ri Wetland (Natural Monument No. 507), which was formed during the late Paleozoic or early Mesozoic era.

Sagot Beach



What kind of beach is Natural Monument No. 391? As soon as you get out of the car, you will get an idea. Strong, solid sand spreads out here for about 3km, which seems to present the perfect natural runway. The water is clear and shallow, making it great for playing with kids.

Simcheonggak Shrine



At Simcheonggak Shrine, you can see Indangsu Sea where Simcheong jumped to sacrifice herself, and Yeonbongbawi Rock, the site of her reincarnation. Because North Korea is clearly visible from here, many homesick displaced people visit this shrine. There are various materials related to Simcheongjeon on the first floor, and a PR center and resting spaces are housed on the 2nd floor. On a clear day, you can have a look at Jangsangot in North Korea.

Junghwa-dong Church Baengnyeong Catholic Church

This was the second church established in Korea (in 1898), following the establishment of Sorae Church in Hwanghae province. The body of Father Taegon Kim, Korea's first Catholic priest, is laid in state in Baengnyeong Catholic Church, which makes the island an important historic place for Korean Catholicism.

Nongyeo Beach-Miadong Beach



The Nongyeo Beach and Miadong Beach merge into one beach at low tide. The sandy island that appears during low tide in front of Growth Ring Rock is exquisite. A rock with a mystery of tens of thousands of years is truly an artistic work assembled on the canvas of these beaches



This beach is surrounded by mountains on both sides to block the winds. The sand is fine and hard, and the water is shallow and crystal clear. It is by far the best spot for swimming on Daecheongdo Island. You can observe the ripple marks and the geological layer of ancient mystery.

Okjukdong Coastal Dune



It is amazing to see a sandy desert on an island. Known as the 'Sahara of Korea! the sand here is so fine and soft that it is swept away with even a gentle wind. A strong wind leaves a long wave pattern on the sand. It is the only place where you can truly leave your footsteps in the sands of time just walking step by step.

Socheongdo Bunbawi Rock & Stromatolite



At night, the moonlit Bunbawi Rock appears white. In the days when there was no lighthouse, ships used the rocks in the distance to find their direction. Stromatolite is a fossil that is produced by cyanobacteria living in the sea or lake. Socheongdo Stromatolite is the oldest bacterial fossil in Korea and is called Ovstershells Rock.



Yeonpyeongdo Island

As you enter the village here, you can see 'Yellow Corbina Tower.' In the past, this place was the best spot for yellow corbinas in Korea. After the shelling from North Korea in 2010, it has now become a famous place for peace and security awareness tourism. The island is still the largest fishing port on the west coast, and you can feel the warm and generous lives of the people on the island.

National Security Training Center

The building bombed by North Korean artillery shells in 2010, was rebuilt and turned into the National Security Training Center. It displays a description of the damages and bombings in Yeonpyeong-ri at that time. It realistically reminds us how horrible a war would be and how precious peace is.

Corbina Museum

This museum introduces the history of Yeonpyeongdo Island, where so many yellow corbinas were caught that a seasonal corbina market used to be held here. You can also see materials about Pungeoje (a ritual for bountiful fish) held in Yeonpyeongdo and for General Im Gyeong-Eop.

The Corbina Museum is a good place to view this rock and beach in the northwestern direction. Byeongpungbawi Rock is one of the magnificent pieces of scenery on Yeonpyeongdo Island having waves, wind, and time carved the rocks into a streched folding screen on the Beach. Garaechilgi beach spreads out alongside Byeongpungbawi Rock. When you step on the beach, you can feel the sea through the sound of the waves.



Manghyang Observatory

Although it may feel a little tough to get there because of the many steps along the way, this observatory offers a close look at North Korea. On special holidays, Koreans separated from families in the north visit this spot to perform ancestral ceremonies with a sense of nostalgia.

During winter, Ice Cream Bawi Rock looks like an ice cream when the rock is covered with frozen snow and seawater.



Wolmi Sea Train

Wolmi Sea Train is Korea's longest monorail, newly introduced to Wolmido Island. The train operates around a 6.1 km section on Wolmido Island for about 33 minutes, and it was selected as one of Korea's 100 most popular tourist attractions in 2019. As it runs on a track at a height of a three-story building, it enables passengers to enjoy a full view of Incheon's Inner Port, the West Sea, and Incheon Bridge in addition to the beautiful landscape of Wolmido Island.
